

How to import your e-Cert into Mozilla Firefox

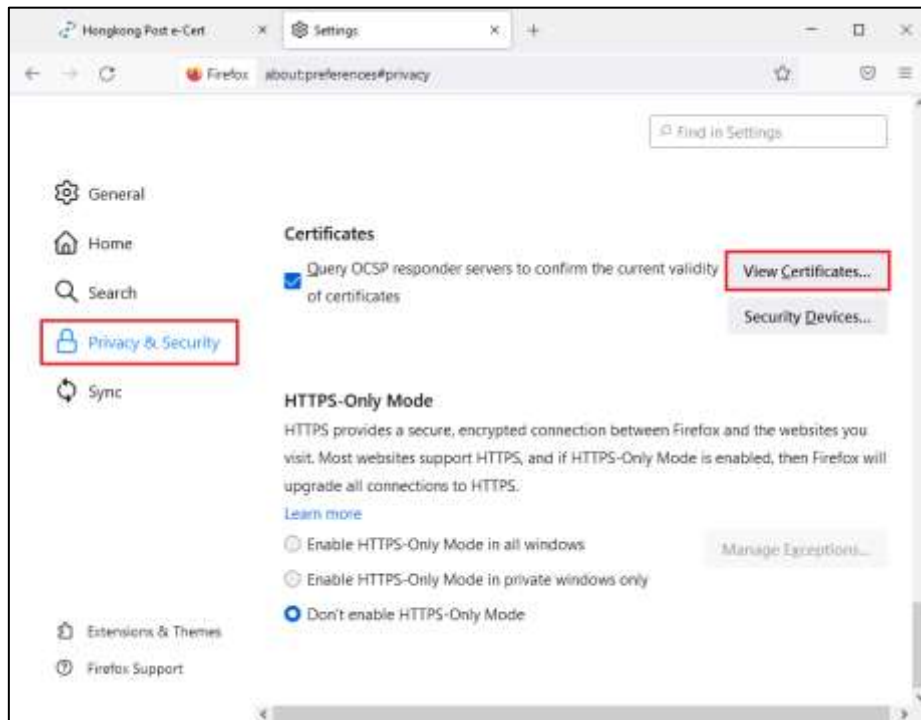
Before you import your certificate, please ensure that:

- A. you are using Mozilla Firefox 68 or above;
- B. you have received the e-Cert file (contained in the e-Cert File USB); and
- C. you have the PIN Envelope provided by Hongkong Post Certification Authority.

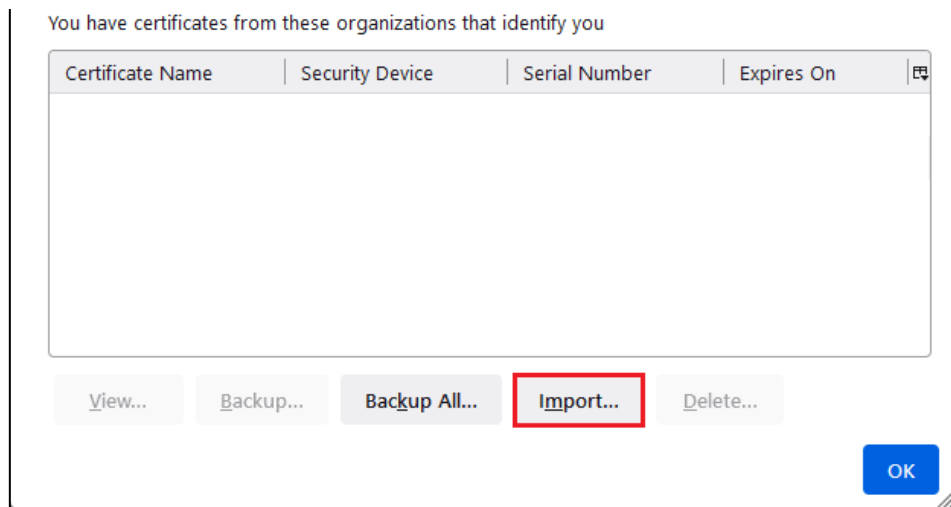
1. Start Firefox, and then select “Settings” from the “Tools” menu.



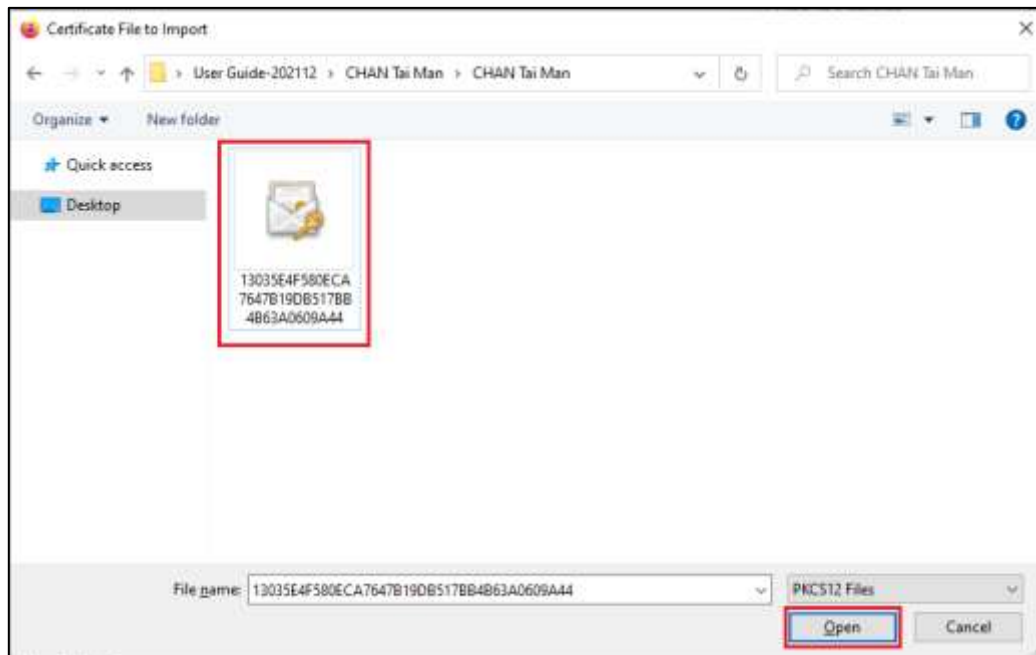
2. Select “Privacy & Security”, and then click “View Certificates”.



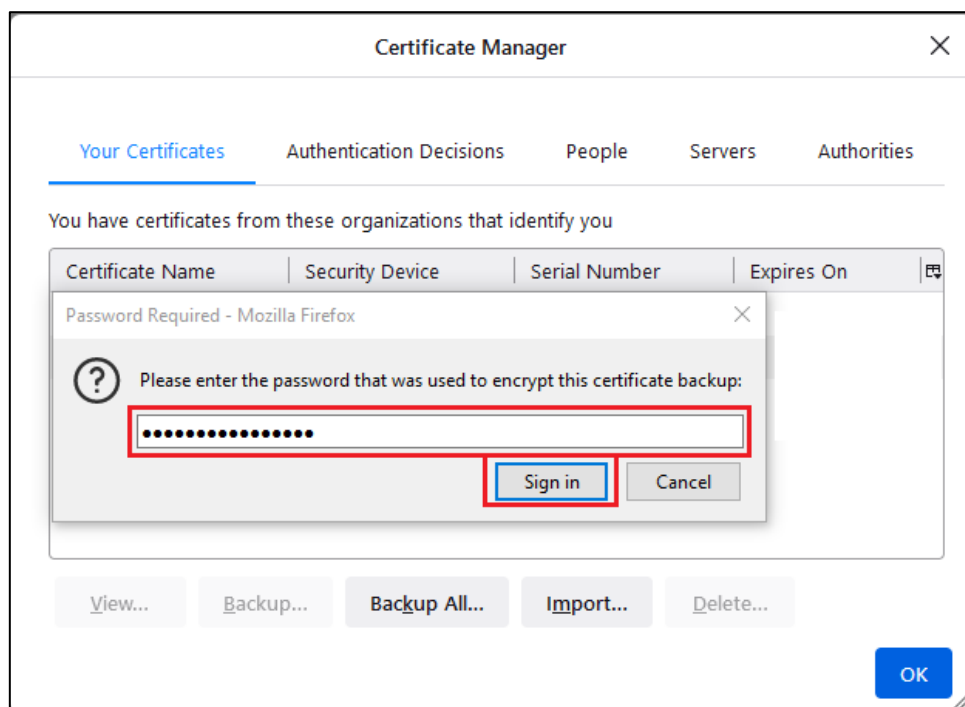
3. Under “Your Certificates” tab, click “Import”.



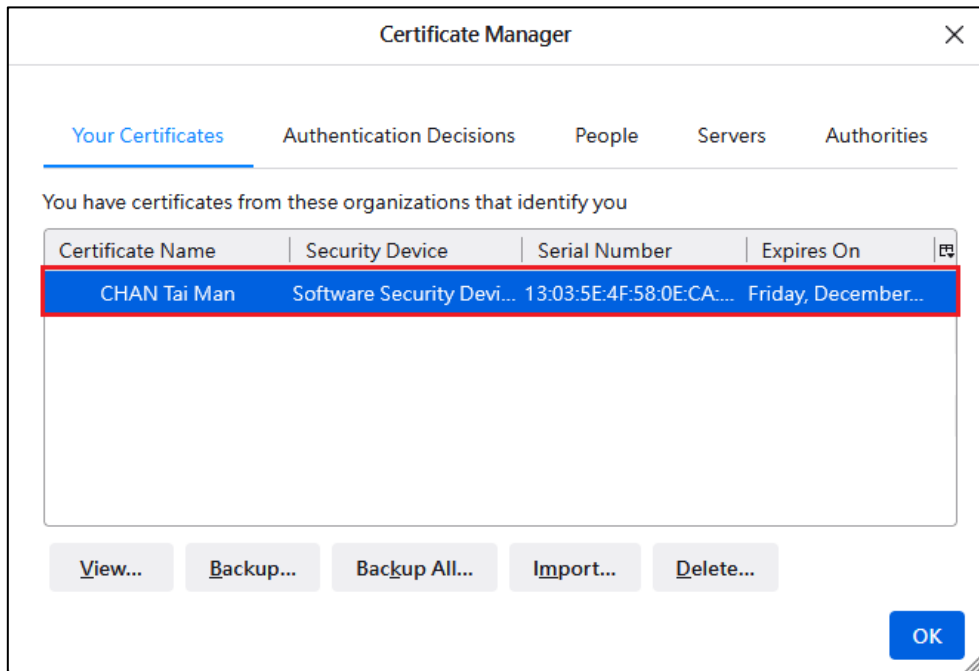
4. Select the e-Cert file from your hard disk, e-Cert File USB or other storage media, and then click “Open”.



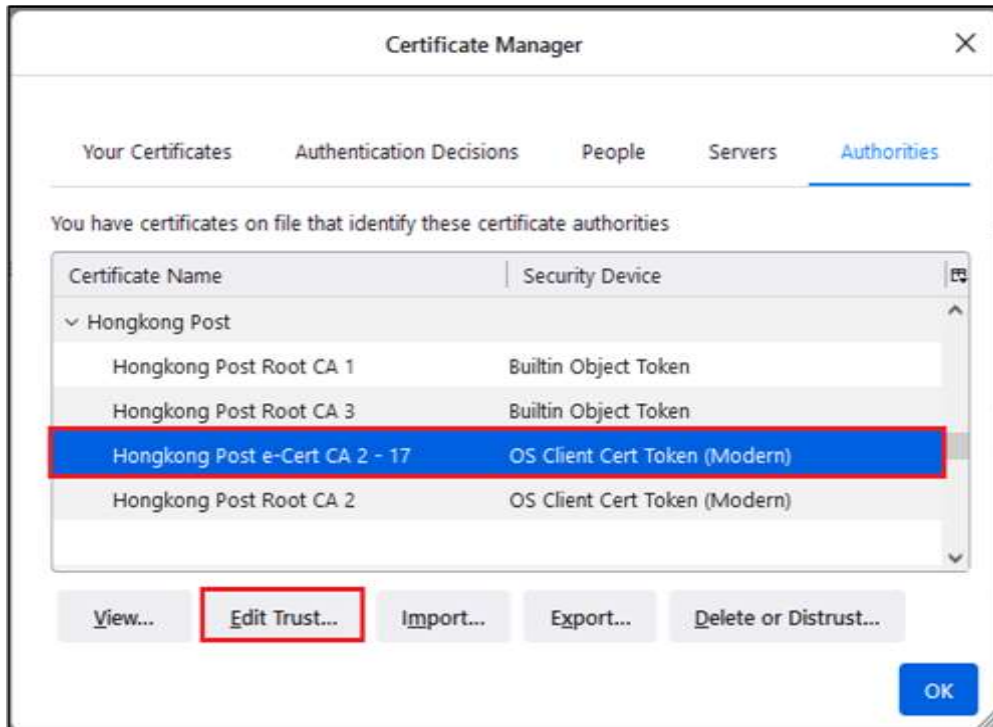
5. Enter the e-Cert password, and then click “Sign in”. (If you have not altered the e-Cert password before, please enter the 16-digit PIN which can be found inside the PIN Envelope. You do not need to input the spaces within the PIN.)



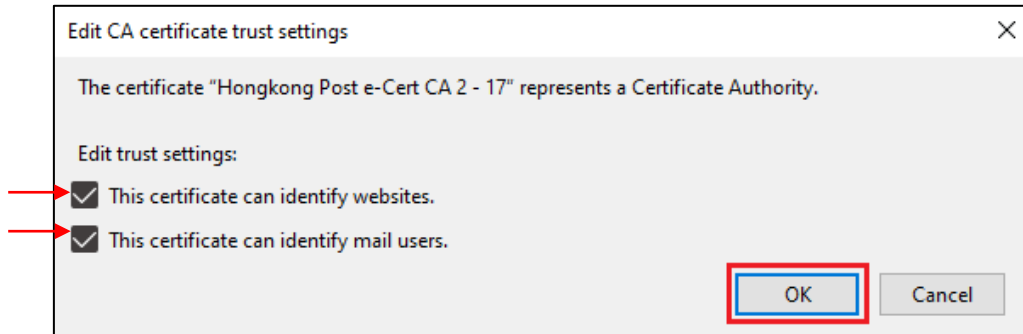
6. Your certificate can be found under “Your Certificates” tab.



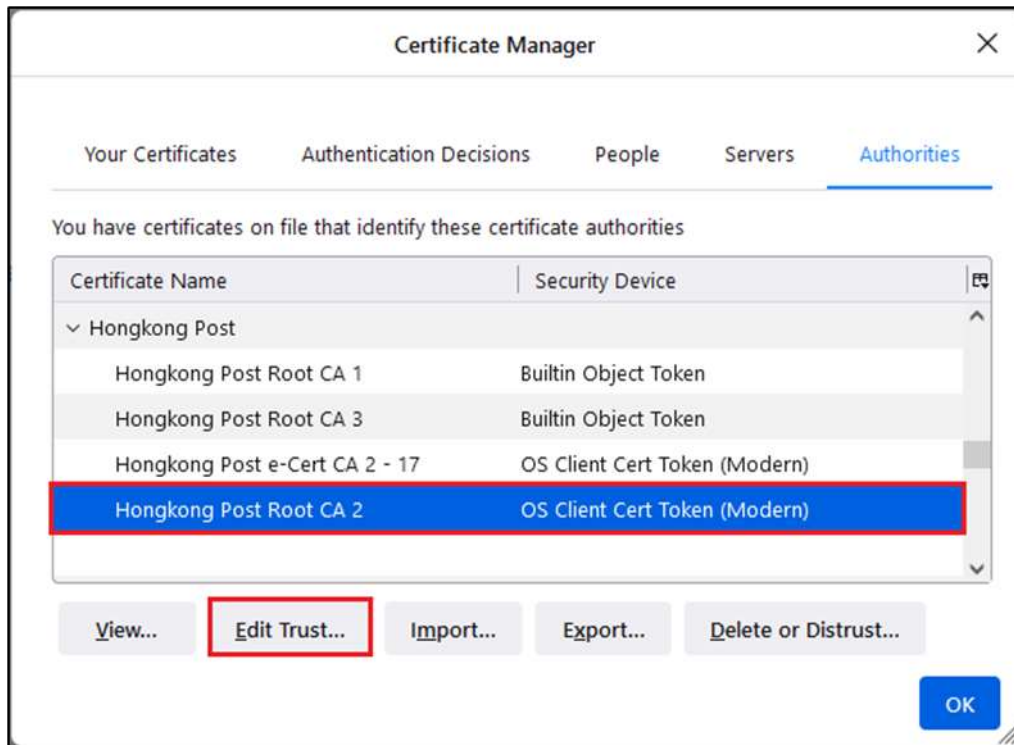
7. Under “Authorities” tab, select “Hongkong Post e-Cert CA 2 - 17” and then click “Edit Trust”.



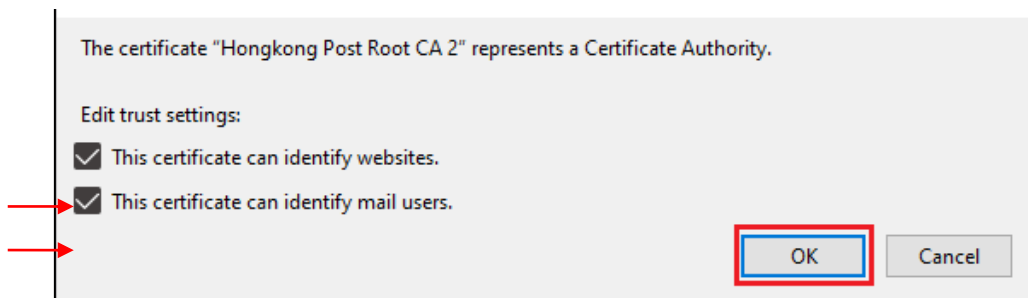
8. Enable all options, and then press “OK”.



9. Under “Authorities” tab, select “Hongkong Post Root CA 2”, and then click “Edit Trust”.

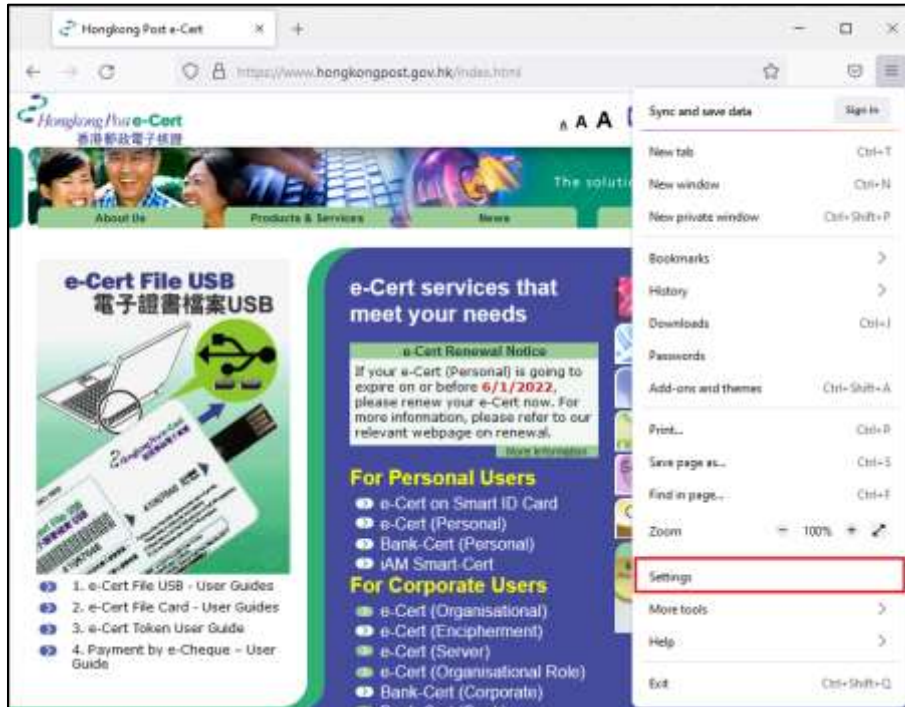


10. Enable all options, and then press “OK”.

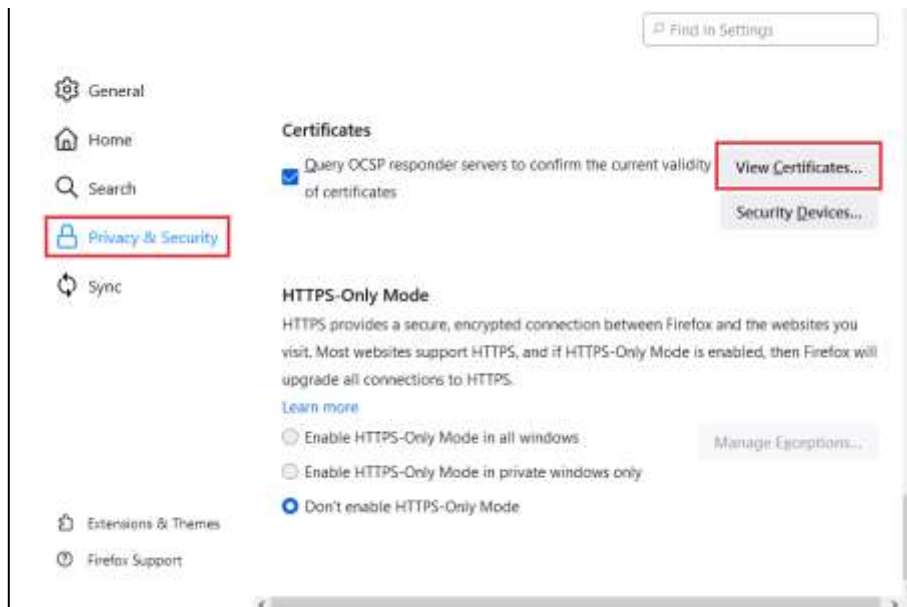


How to view your e-Cert in Mozilla Firefox
